Swamp Fox Rides

Whizzin' to Philly

This is the story of how a 1951 Whizzer Sportsman Motorbike made it to the AACA National Award Stage in Philadelphia Pa.in Feb.2020. The story really starts in 1951 when a 12 year old kid got his first taste of something with 2 wheels and a motor. That was the year I got my hands on a beat up 1946 Whizzer motorbike and I was hooked forever more. By the time I was 14 I had a pretty good business going buying junk Whizzers, fixing them up and selling them to other aficionados of the marque!!

I had enough money saved up by my 14th birthday and was able to purchase a slightly used 1951 Whizzer Sportsman for the princely price of \$50. The kid that had it didn't want it and his Dad sold it to me. Man, I was in Whizzer heaven. Even at that time a Sportsman was just about the most desirable of all the Whizzer models you could get. I got it running and for almost 2 years, that was my transportation to school and well, anywhere I wanted to go! I wore it out, rebuilt it, wore it out again and rebuilt it one more time. By that time I was 16 and my girlfriend of the month did not want to ride on the back of my Whizzer any more. I graduated to a 1940 Ford coupe and Whizzers were forgotten for many years.

Fast forward to around 1990 and thanks to a buddy of mine who bought an old Whizzer motor, that he knew nothing about and called me to see if I knew anything about a Whizzer, I got the "bug" again. As most of you know, I have restored one of every model that Whizzer built over the years and have a collection of them that I show in AACA competition and also ride when the weather is good.

The Sportsman is still my favorite motor bike. I have 2 that are duplicates of my original Green Sportsman. One is a 1950 model and the one that got the AACA National Award in the Mini-cycle Category is a 1951 model, the same as the one I rode when I was 14. It was partially restored by a friend of mine from Canada and I completed the restoration in early 2019. I entered it into AACA competition at the South Eastern National AACA meet in Charlotte in 2019 and received the 1st Junior award. It was nominated by a National Award Panel of judges to compete in the Mini-cycle category at that meet.

It is a real honor just to be nominated for a National Award and I really was surprised when I got the letter that said I would be receiving the Award at the AACA Annual meeting in Philly this year. Now you know how a 1951 Whizzer Sportsman got to the Award Stage in Philly!!!


