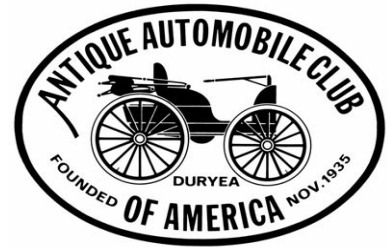

## Welcome to Charlotte



The Hornets Nest Region extends a cordial Welcome to all fellow AACA members attending the Southeastern Division Nationals.

The Nationals will take place at the Embassy Suites on April 9-10, 2021. The Nationals site is most easily accessed from Interstate 485, using the US 29 exit—the Embassy Suites is about two miles North.

The Region is especially pleased that you have chosen to participate in the Nationals as the Region has undergone a major effort to have this event in April 2021.

The April 2021 Charlotte AutoFair has been canceled because of North Carolina Covid-19 restrictions on large venues.

### Charlotte Area Attractions

Charlotte Motor Speedway is the hub of NASCAR racing facilities to be found in the larger Charlotte metropolitan area. Near the Speedway, Concord Mills Shopping Center is situated at Interstate 85 Exit 49—about two miles from the Speedway and US29 on Bruton Smith Blvd. This is one of the world famous Mills destination malls and includes a Bass Pro Shop, many specialty stores, and a multitude of restaurants.

Uptown Charlotte, has Discovery Place, a hands-on science museum for adults and children; the Mint Museum Complex on South Tryon Street; the NBA Charlotte Hornets Arena. Bank of America Stadium, home of the NFL Carolina Panthers, has a team memorabilia shop in the Stadium at Mint Street and Stonewall Street. The NASCAR Hall of Fame is on Brevard Street in uptown Charlotte near the Convention Center. Also, there is a light rail train line that runs a route from UNCC on North Tryon Street (about four miles from the Speedway) to uptown, and South to the Pineville area.

### Registration Deadline March 22, 2021

**Early Model Vehicles Receive a Special Welcome!** Trailer parking will be provided across Bruton Smith Blvd for all trailers, including early models. Travel distance to the show field is about one mile. Police Officers will be stationed on Bruton Smith Blvd to stop traffic and allow show cars to cross over to the Embassy Suites. Let AACA see those early vehicles that made automotive history!

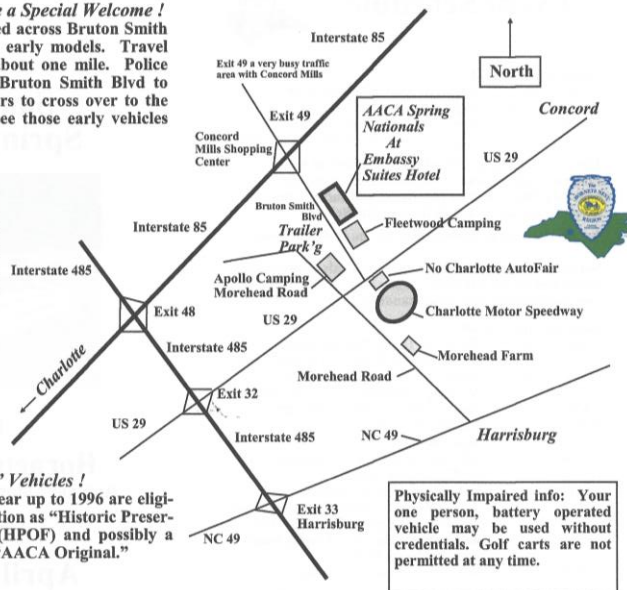

### Friday

The vehicle registration pick-up will be at the entrance to the AACA Nationals Field - opening at 10 AM. Race Car and Two-Wheeler condition runs will begin in the morning in the Rock City Campground across Bruton Smith Blvd from the Embassy Suites. The AACA Judging School will take place this year at the Embassy Suites Hotel. Two sessions are expected to be held on Friday. Judges Newsletter will include the schedule and more details for Judging School.

### Saturday

Vehicle registration pick-up continues at the entrance to the AACA Nationals Field where vehicles may begin entering at 7 AM. The Judges Breakfast is suspended for 2021 due to Covid-19 concerns. Judges will meet their Team Captains at 9 AM for coordination - please have breakfast before arriving at the Show Field. All vehicles must be on the Field for judging to begin at 11 AM and remain until released by the Chief Judge at 3 PM.

AACA Awards will begin about 4 PM, outside, next to the Field. An umbrella is highly recommended just for the occasion that Spring Showers might occur. You will certainly want to take your Trophy home from the Show Field rather than wait until later!

The usual after awards Picnic is suspended for 2021 due to Covid-19 concerns.

### Vehicle Trailers and Motor Home Parking

A location has been reserved across Bruton Smith Blvd from the Embassy Suites for Antique Vehicle trailers, haulers, RVs and motor homes. All must be self contained. All the space will be assigned and must be pre-registered. Windshield stickers are required for entry. Windshield stickers and maps will be mailed to you, in advance, for this parking location. No windshield stickers will be sold at the gate. Full-time, secured trailer parking is provided Friday morning at 10 AM through Sunday morning at 10 AM.
