- A. Production. Only two deviations, from production, are allowed without penalty points being assessed. Each deviation more than two, counts five (5) judging points per deviation. Parts or equipment that has an Original Equipment Manufacturer's part number stamped or cast into part, is an exact Original Equipment Manufacturer's reproduction, or a direct factory replacement in appearance and function are not considered deviations. These parts must have been available for that year and model car, truck, or vehicle.
B. Judge's classifications are final. Judging sheets are not for participant inspection.
C. All jeeps (not military) and SUVs will be classified as a truck.
D. Class 24, Special Interest, applies to all vehicles not otherwise being clearly defined by one of the other twenty-five classes.
